#### RULES AND REGULATIONS :

To help keep a pleasant environment on the campground  
please recognise that the application of RESPECT is our priority.

##### Occupancy

- The rate for one site includes 2 adults and children under the age of 18.
- One camping unit and one vehicle per site is authorized.
- No trade or business is allowed either on your campsite or anywhere else on the campground without prior authorisation.
- Washing your camping unit or vehicle with a hose is forbidden.
- Curfew is at 11:00 p.m. All radios must be turned off and musical instruments put away. You may still stay by your fire past curfew as long as your neighbours are not disturbed.
- All your visitors have left the campground no later than 10:30 p.m.

##### Circulation

- Speed limit is 8km/h everywhere on campground.
- The excessive or abusive circulation of vehicles, will not be tolerated (including bicycle).
- Bicycles may circulate after dark with appropriate lighting.

##### Parking

- All vehicles must be parked on their own campsite. Unless they have taken prior authorisation.
- A second vehicle or your visitor's vehicle must be parked outside the camping.

##### Other

- Fireworks, firecrackers, chinese lantern or any kind of weapon is strictly prohibited.
- All children under the age of 14 must return to their campsite before 10:00 p.m.
- All pets must always be on a leash and please do not leave your pet unattended while you are out and most important of all please pick up the excrement.
